HORTICULTURAL SHOW RULES

1. Judging will take place at 9:00am. No one will be allowed to be present during the judging, except those retained by the Committee. This rule will be strictly enforced..
2. All flowers etc sent for competition must be *bona fide* property of the competitor or his employer.
3. Only one entry per competitor & will count for prize money or for points.
4. Where a prize is offered for "the most successful competitor" or "the competitor obtaining most points", the award will be to the competitor having the highest aggregate marks in the sections concerned, calculated as follows: For a first prize 3 marks, second 2, third 1. In the event of equality the competitor with most first prizes shall be declared the winner.
5. The decision of the judges shall, in all cases, be final. Judges are empowered to withhold prizes in any class where the exhibitors are not considered worthy of prizes.
6. Any prize found to have been unfairly obtained will be forfeited and, if any article is discovered to have been tampered with of the purpose of deception, the exhibitor of such, besides being exposed, will forfeit all his prize money.
7. The Society will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, flowers, stands, or other articles while in the Show, but all ordinary care will be taken of these.
8. The committee shall have power to refuse the entry, or entries of any competitor without assigning any reason.
9. All matters not provided for in the foregoing rules shall be left to the discretion of the Steward, whose decision is final.

1. 'It's a Small World' – A miniature exhibit. Space allowed **Beginner** – Width 10cm, Depth 10cm & Height 15cm
 2. 'The Golden Ticket' – Props may be used, a mixture of **Beginner** dry & fresh flowers foliage. Max space allowed – Width 50cm, Depth 50cm, Height no restriction.

1. 'Hot & Spicy' – Table top floral arrangement. Judged **Intermediate** from the front only. Max space allowed – Width 50cm, Depth 50cm, Height 60cm
 2. 'Welcome to the Jungle' – Your own interpretation, Proj **Intermediate** may be used. Max space allowed - Width 60cm, Depth 60cm, Height no restriction.

1. 'After the Fire' – Table top flower/foliage arrangement, **Open** incorporating up to 2 pieces of burnt timber. To be view all round. Max space allowed - Width 50cm, Depth 50cm, Height 60cm
 2. 'All the Jazz' – Own interpretation. Max space allowed **Open** Width 100cm, Depth 100cm, Height no restriction.
 3. 'Green Fingers' – An exhibit within a basket using folia **Open** only. To be viewed all round. Max space allowed - Wid 60cm, Depth 60cm, Height no restriction
