HORTICULTURAL SHOW RULES

1. Judging will take place at 9:00am. Entries should be taken to the Showfield before 8.00am on Show Day
2. No one will be allowed to be present during the judging, except those retained by the Committee. This rule will be strictly enforced..
3. All flowers etc sent for competition must be *bona fide* property of the competitor or his employer.
4. Only one entry per competitor & will count for prize money or for points.
5. Handicrafts, jams and chutneys (only) can be dropped off at Garden House, Westbury Road between 10 am and midday and 6p.m. and 8p.m. on Friday 26th July 2024 before the Show
6. Exhibits in Handicrafts sections must not have been previously shown at Nairn Show
7. Food exhibits not collected at 4pm will be discarded
8. Exhibitors please uplift all exhibits AFTER the children's prizegiving at 4pm
9. Exhibitors wishing exhibits uplifted for show, contact Steward by 22nd July
10. Where a prize is offered for "the most successful competitor" or "the competitor obtaining most points", the award will be to the competitor having the highest aggregate marks in the sections concerned, calculated as follows: For a first prize 3 marks, second 2, third 1. In the event of equality the competitor with most first prizes shall be declared the winner.
11. The decision of the judges shall, in all cases, be final. Judges are empowered to withhold prizes in any class where the exhibitors are not considered worthy of prizes.
12. Any prize found to have been unfairly obtained will be forfeited and, if any article is discovered to have been tampered with of the purpose of deception, the exhibitor of such, besides being exposed, will forfeit all his prize money.
13. The Society will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, flowers, stands, or other articles while in the Show, but all ordinary care will be taken of these.
14. The committee shall have power to refuse the entry, or entries of any competitor without assigning any reason.
15. All matters not provided for in the foregoing rules shall be left to the discretion of the Steward, whose decision is final.

Entries to be taken to the field before 0800 on show day. Judged on show day.
