REGULATIONS

Livestock may be refused entry to the Grand Parade unless properly halter trained - at the Safety Steward's & Parade Steward's discretion

- 1 The competition in stock, unless otherwise stated, is open to all members of the Nairnshire Farming Society and to all farmers in the County.

 2 All cattle stock must be genuinely the property of, and in possession of, the exhibitor.
- 3 All sheep stock must be genuinely the property of, and in possession of, the exhibitor for two months prior to the show.
- 4 Challenge cups and special prizes are open for competition to all competitors unless otherwise stated.
- 5 All stock and other exhibits must be on the ground by **8:30am and cannot be** removed until AFTER the Grand Parade.
- 6 Entries must be made to the Administrator on or before 30th June on forms supplied, with correct entry fee. Exhibitors who have failed to pay their entry fee will forfeit any prize money won on show day.
- The age of stock in beef cattle sections to be calculated from 1st October, unless otherwise stated.
- 8 No bull may be shown unless properly controlled.
- 9 For prizes given by the Society, no animal shall be allowed to enter in more than one class, or to compete in any class, except that prescribed for animals of its pedigree and description.
- 10 Exhibitors are alone responsible for the accuracy and eligibility of the entries in the catalogue.
- 11 The judges are empowered to withhold prizes in any class where the exhibits are not considered worthy of prizes.
- 12 Where a prize is offered for "the most successful exhibitor" of "for the competitor obtaining most points", the award will be made to the competitor having the highest aggregate marks in the section concerned, calculated as follows: For a first prize - 4 marks; second 3 marks, third 2 marks, commended 1 mark. (In the event of a tie, one mark will be added to the aggregate of each candidate for every exhibit he made before the judges in the section concerned.)
- 13 No protest will be considered unless made in writing, and accompanied by a deposit of £5, to the Secretary Hut by 2pm on the day of the show. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
- 14 All persons in charge of stock or other exhibits shall be subject to the order of the committee, the attending members, or the Secretary.
- 15 The committee will not be responsible if any exhibit is not turned out for judging when called.
- 16 Any member or competitor offering insulting language to a judge, member of committee, official or attending member, or otherwise misconducting himself, shall, in the option of the committee, forfeit all entry money and prizes and, in the case of a member, be liable to expulsion from the Society.
- 17 The Society will not be in any way responsible for any loss or damage which stock, implements or articles of any description may sustain at the show or in transit, or for any accident to any person within or without the show yard.
- 18 Any unregistered pure female or registered steer may be shown in Section 8.
- 19. Where the Society is affiliated to breed societies, their show regulations also apply.
- 20.By entering, competitors are agreeing to their data being held by the society and published via media related to show reporting. This data will not be sold and only shared with relevant government bodies if required by law.

NOTE - if the meaning of any of the fore-mentioned rules is questioned, the final interpretation of them shall lie with the President's committee.

NORTH SHOWS CIRCUIT YOUNG FARMERS' CALF COMPETITION Competition Rules

- 1. The competition is open to affiliated members of SAYFC aged 14 and over, and under 30.
- 2. Participating shows are: Black Isle, Caithness, Grantown, Latheron, Nairn and Sutherland.
- 3. The entrant to show a calf born on or after 1st March of year prior to show.
- 4. One entry per person, per class. There is no limit to the number of classes a person may enter.
- 5. There will be 2 Pedigree classes and 2 Commercial classes at each show calf born between 1st March and 1st September AND calf born between 2nd September and show day.
- 6. In each class, entrants will be judged on three elements Stockmanship, Ringcraft and Quality of the Animal. Up to five points will be awarded based on each of the three separate elements.
- 7. At each show Stockmanship will be judged anonymously by a separate judge.
- 8. The points for all three elements are awarded to and follow the animal.
- 9. If there is a large entry, the class will be split into stot and heifer sections.
- 10.Ear tags must be entered prior to show day.
- 11. The Overall Young Farmers' Calf Champion and Reserve at each show will be judged between the Pedigree YF champion and the Commercial YF champion and reserves. In the event of a tie the Overall Cattle Judge will make the final decision.
- 12.At each show the points will be recorded and sent to Grantown Show. The overall winner will be announced, and the trophy presented at Grantown Show.
- 13. Engraving of the trophy and its return to Grantown Show the following year shall be the responsibility of the recipient.
- 14.A Commercial Calf **CANNOT** be shown in another class in the Commercial Section **BUT CAN** compete for the Commercial Champion.
- 15.A Pedigree calf may be shown in another Pedigree class (under members name only) and can compete for Pedigree Champion.
- 16.Prize money at each participating show: Champion - £50, Reserve - £30 (provided by each show)
- 17.Prize money annually for the OVERALL competition champion will be provided by the competition sponsor and presented at the Grantown Show. Champion £100, Reserve £25.


